

From One Minister to Another...

In two Sundays, on August 18, we will take some time in worship to celebrate the rich contributions and ministry of our Sunday School teachers. These devoted volunteers give of their time and gifts for teaching for the edification of their classes.

Sunday School began in the UK in 1751, with the goal of educating children who did not have access to the English private education that was reserved exclusively for the wealthy and for males. (There were no public schools, and school was not compulsory.)

As public education became more prevalent, Sunday School shifted to an emphasis on biblical literacy, hymn singing, and memorization of Bible verses.

Unfortunately, many adults feel that Sunday School is a program primarily for children. Nothing could be further from the truth. If you've gotten out of the habit of attending Sunday School—or if you've never sought out a Sunday School class—our appreciation of First Baptist's Sunday School teachers would be a wonderful time to begin a beneficial new spiritual practice.

Why should you attend Sunday School?

Sunday School is the best way to become more involved in the life of the church. It's so difficult to form connections and find your place through a brief conversation before or after Sunday morning worship. Sunday School offers you an opportunity to get to know others and to have others get to know you.

Attending Sunday School helps improve your knowledge of the Bible. A Sunday School class offers you the opportunity to study and learn with others, to ask questions, and to think through Bible stories together.

Sunday School classes provide a community, a place to belong. It's a great place to make friends, form connections, and share joys and burdens.
